

Emerging House Budget Resolution = Same Architecture as Past Plans (and Trump)

- Assumes trillions in entitlement cuts, with reconciliation instructions to immediately identify \$200 billion of those cuts over the next decade
- Includes reconciliation instructions to fast-track tax reform
 - Potentially allows entitlement cuts to pay for tax cuts
- Large increases in 2018 defense spending, above President Trump's request
- Cuts non-defense spending below sequestration level in 2018 – and likely far deeper in the out years
- Claims of balanced budget

Ask to members of Congress: Will you commit to **OPPOSING** any budget that...

- **Requires cuts in key programs that helps struggling families afford the basics, including food on the table, a roof over their heads, and access to health care**
- **Paves the way for tax cuts that will lose revenue** (causing deep spending cuts in the future) and that benefit mostly the wealthy and corporations
- **Cuts investments in non-defense discretionary programs** and instead work toward a responsible budget deal that will reduce or eliminate the harmful sequestration cuts that otherwise will take full effect in 2018
