

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About the Resources

- Two directories, located at <u>https://www.moconnectionsforhealth.org/lgbtq-equity-group/</u>
- Created by MCH with input from the former LGBTQ+ Healthy Aging and Equity group (now part of the LGBT Older Adult Alliance)
- Intended to be a library of information that can help individuals and organizations reach and serve the LGBTQ+ community more effectively.

Criteria for Directory Listings

- Listings are not for advertising purposes.
- No for-profit listings or ads are allowed
- Listings may be created from public-facing digital sources or may be submitted by organizations
- When listings are submitted by known entities, MCH staff double-checks any links for functionality, then adds them to the directory
- Listings from unknown sources are checked more thoroughly (i.e. phone numbers tested, may reach out to other area organizations to verify identity)

Directory 1: Organizations Serving LGBTQ+ Missourians

- Intended Audiences:
 - LGBTQ+ Missourians seeking resources in their area
 - Organizations who want to collaborate with organizations that focus on the LGTBQ+ population
- Information Included:
 - Organization name and contact information
 - Target age group and target population (i.e. HIV+, Transgender/Gender Diverse, etc.)
 - Information about mailing lists and community calendars

Directory 1: Organizations

- After clicking the link, users are directed to a public google sheet.
- Anyone can view, but only certain MCH staff have edit access
- The header row and a link to the MCH site are pinned to the top for ease

Directory 2: Events Targeting LGBTQ+ Missourians

- Intended Audiences:
 - Organizations who want to conduct outreach at LGBTQ+ events
- o Information Included:
 - Event Name, target audience, description, and basic information
 - Contact information for vendors and other notes
 - Event frequency
 - Past recurring events are included, so organizations can plan to participate in future events

Directory 2: Events

- After clicking the link, users are directed to a public google sheet.
 - Same basic setup and features as the directory of organizations.


